General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Co-ordinate and lead a programme for children which caters as far as possible for their spiritual and social needs. You could follow our current format of children's activities: Toddler Group, Wednesday Club (yrs 3-6) & Sunday School, or re-vision what the children's ministry looks like alongside the children's work team. If you decide to re-vision then the details of the job specification may look different.
- Exercise active pastoral care for the children
- Seek to disciple the children
- Build and maintain relationships with the children and their families.
- Seek to build relationships with children and families in the local community and to be a blessing to them
- Be responsible for coordinating safeguarding, health and safety and first aid at activities and events.
- Attend Sunday Services regularly and become part of our church community
- Nurture your own spiritual development
- Work within the guidance of the pastors, children's director and church board.
- Help promote effective team work in conjunction with other staff and volunteers especially to work closely with the children's director.
- Mentor and encourage other leaders within the children's work of the church
- Facilitate the running of residential events.
- Undertake any other duties as maybe required from time to time.
